Join us for the first-of-its-kind Diocesan Eucharistic Congress, the showcase event of the National Eucharistic Revival's inaugural year.

The National Eucharistic Revival, which kicked off across the United States last June, aims to teach or restore understanding on the True Presence by helping all renew their worship of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist.

The March 25 bilingual Congress will feature presentations by national Eucharistic preachers, Father Patrick Hyde, OP, and Father Joseph Jean-Louis, from the Archdiocese of Miami; witness talks by local lay Catholics, morning and Rosary prayers, and a concluding Mass celebrated by Bishop Dennis Sullivan. Doors open at 8:00 AM at Camden's Freedom Mortgage Pavilion.

The event will conclude with a short lunch break. You are welcome to bring your own food into the facility. Limited pavilion concessions will also be available.
